


## Understanding Response States and Workflow



## **OSCAR Response States**

- 1. Unscored Response has zero scores applied and waiting for a first score. It is possible that a response in an unscored state has a flag associated with it but was released back to the pool, therefore still in the unscored state.
- 2. Reliability Response has 1 score applied and waiting for a second score. It is possible that a response in has a flag associated with it but was released back to the pool, since it has the first score applied it would be in reliability state.
- 3. Resolution Response has a 1st score and 2nd score applied and waiting for its resolution read (3rd read)
- **4. Complete** A response that has all the score values required by the item type configuration.
- 5. Withheld A response that was flagged and has not been released back to the pool. Withheld responses that are never released back to the pool will remain in the withheld state through project completion.

## **OSCAR Flagging**

- 1. **Flagged** A response that has a flag associated with it.
- Flagged Reviewed A response that has a flag associated with it and the flag has been marked as reviewed.
- **3. Releasing Flags** Once a response is flagged it moves to a withheld state. A supervisor can then review the flag and release the response back into the pool. It is not required that the flag is marked reviewed to release it back to the scoring pool.

## **Review Condition Code**

OSCAR has a feature that allows an admin to create a trait condition code as a "Review" type.

If this feature is used and a scorer selects the review condition code the response moves to a "Review" queue. A supervisor must review and score the response before it can be removed from this queue
